PIEDMONT SAILORS—Our 2012 Reunion will be in Omaha, NE Sept. 26-30. We will check in on Wed., Sept. 26 and leave on Sun., Sept. 30, 2012. Registration deadline is drawing near, Sept. 5, 2012.

Now for some of the details:

HOTEL: The host hotel is the COMFORT INN & SUITES, Omaha Central, 7007 Grover St., Omaha, NE 68106. The phone no. is 402-934-4900 and website is www. Omahacomfortinn.com For those driving in, the hotel is located just off I 80 at the exit for W. 72nd St., about 2 blocks to the north on Grover St. Comp shuttle service to and from Omaha airport is available as well as service within a 5 mile radius of the hotel. Free auto and RV parking. The hotel is recently renovated and features the Firewater Grill for dining service. There is a complimentary Deluxe breakfast including biscuits & gravy, scrambled eggs, sausages, cereals, pastries, yogurts, Belgian waffles, juice, coffee, etc. USA TODAY & Omaha World Herald are available at no cost. There is a work-out room and indoor swimming pool. Comp 24 hour coffee service is available. Rooms with a king or double queens are available; up to 4 people per room; and pets are welcome. All of this for \$68.00 per room per night, plus 18.16 % taxes. These rates are in effect 3 days prior and after reunion dates. Be sure and ask for Piedmont Reunion rates. If there are any problems, please let me know. At the Hotel, there will be a Wed. evening Sept. 26 pasta buffet starting at 6 PM and the Sat. evening banquet on Sept 29 at 6 PM. These will be included in the registration fee. If you have special dietary needs or ADA needs, please specify at time of your reservation. HOTEL ROOM RESERVATION DEADLINE IS SEPT. 5, 2012.

BUS TOURS: The Thursday, Sept. 27th tour is from 8:00 to 5:00 PM and both coaches will travel together. However on Fri., Sept. 28th, each coach will have their own schedule due to visiting sites that can take only a limited number of people at one time.

The sites that will be visited on Thurs. include an Omaha city tour with guide, lunch buffet (you pay) and tour of Boys Town, and the Strategic Air and Space Museum at Ashland, NE west of Omaha on I 80. All admission fees will be included in registration package.

The Friday, Sept. 28th tour bus # 1 will leave at 8:15 AM and return by 4:30 PM. Bus # 2 will leave at 9:15 AM and return at 5:00 PM. Both buses will be together for lunch at the Czech Bohemian Café, excellent food and plentiful. The sites visited will include the Toilet Paper Factory (has contract for all military TP supplies), American Soldier Exhibit at the Durham Museum, and a 1927 pipe organ performance that has a patriotic flavor. This site can take only 50 people at one time so the 2 busses will visit at different times. It is unique in that it is installed in a very large private home in a residential area, well worth seeing and hearing. HOSPITALITY ROOM: We will use Ballroom A & B for registration and meetings. The dinners will be served in Ballroom D. Registration opens at 12 noon Wed., Sept. 26. Jack & Marge Chesnick along with Willie & Aslaug Williams will stock snacks, drinks, etc. in this room. We can serve our own beer, wine, etc. or a bar will be set up and serve a variety of drinks (help yourself) at \$2 or \$3 each. There will be space for Piedmont mementos as well as GIFTS TO BE RAFFLED AT THE FRIDAY NIGHT FUNDRAISER. Be sure and bring something for the raffle.
