National Museum of the US Air Force its galleries present military aviation history boasting many rare and one of a kind planes, missiles and engines. One of the more interesting items is the Presidential Gallery which displays aircraft that were used by President's Roosevelt, Truman, Eisenhower and Kennedy. You can look at the lift built for Roosevelt so he could enter his aircraft in his wheel chair and walk thru SAM 26000 the same plane that took Kennedy to Dallas and returned his body to Washington on 22 November 1963.
