As always these rates are good 3 day prior and 3 days after the reunion for anyone who desires to arrive early or stay later. Contact the hotel at 1-303-340-3800 and ask for the Piedmont/Dixie rate of \$119.00. Make your reservations early; you must cancel 24 hours in advance to avoid being charged. All registration forms must be in no later than 31 July so we can lock in Buses and meals.

Three days of tours have been setup and I am sure you will enjoy the sites we have selected as well as the beautiful fall foliage and of course the Rocky Mountains.
